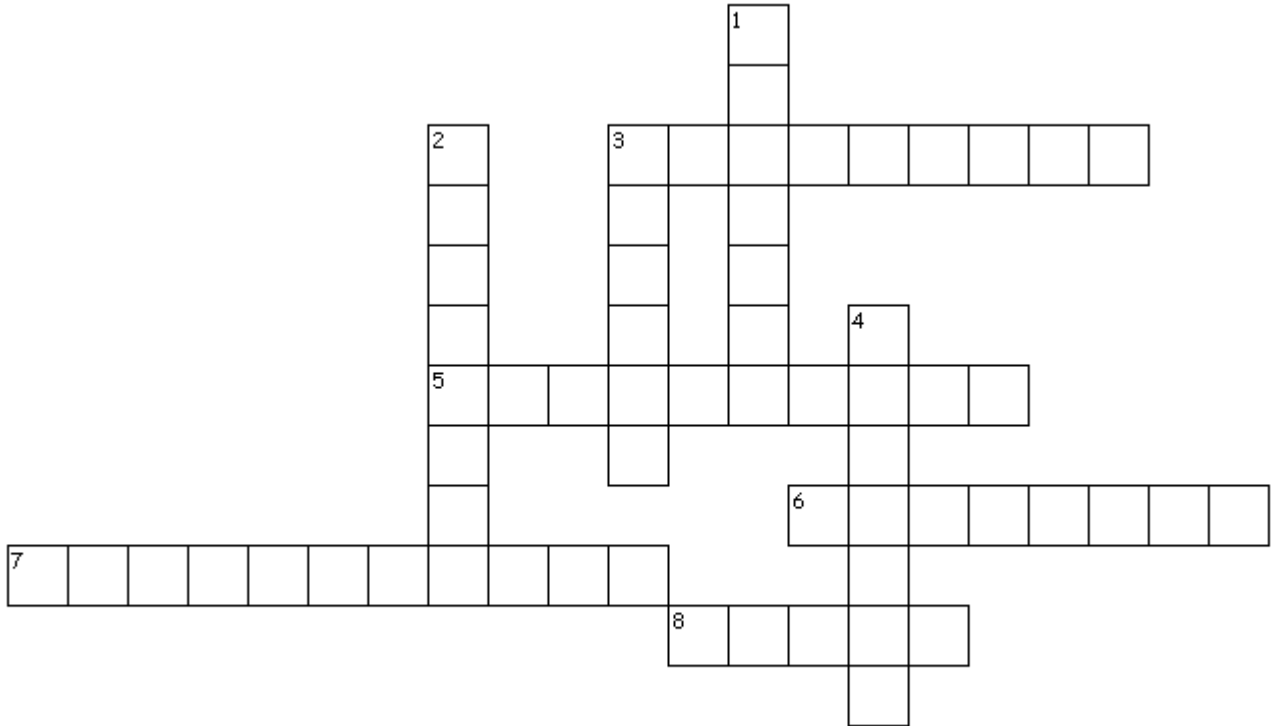


Seeds-(High School)
